

## MT. GILEAD RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Mt. Gilead Church furnishings are old and fragile, particularly the pews, pulpit and chairs. You are welcome to move the furnishings, but please do so with care.
2. **NO open flame candles, only battery operated candles allowed.**
3. The person renting the facility is responsible for insuring that all guests or members of their group are aware of and comply with the rules governing the use of the facility. Abuse of the rules will result in forfeiture of the deposit.
4. All doors must be locked at any time when the building is not attended by a responsible adult.
5. No chewing gum is allowed inside the building. Smoking and other tobacco use is prohibited in or on the grounds.
6. Both doormats will be placed directly inside the doors.
7. The church and grounds will be cleaned after use and all trash placed in the barrels behind the restrooms. Any furniture that has been moved will need to be back in its original location/position.
8. Please use gravel areas for all parking.
9. The damage deposit will be forfeited if any damage to the facility is found or it has not been cleaned after use. Staff will inspect the facility before the deposit is returned.
